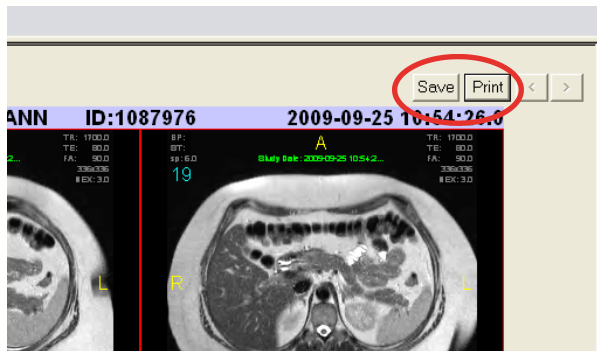


# Key Images in PACS

In some studies, our radiologists identify key images that denote pathology or other areas of interest. The key images appear next to the final report in the patient folder in PACS, when you click to view the selected study icon.



As these images are important to the patient's diagnosis, they can be printed and saved to a paper file, saved to a file on a computer, or loaded into an EMR in a few easy steps. When viewing key images in the patient folder, simply click the "Save" button to save the images as a bitmap, JPEG, or tiff to a file on your computer. Click "Print" to send to a printer, or print and save as a pdf.
