Olympic Radiology installs new Multi-Slice CT

Olympic Radiology is pleased to announce the installation of its new Multi-slice CT. Installation will begin on Thursday, June 1 and continue thru the weekend. This will cause the least amount of disruption to our schedule. Starting Monday June 5th, we will have 3-4 days of limited scheduling while our technologists receive advanced training.

One of the biggest benefits that your patients will experience will be the elimination of oral contrast requirements prior to most exams. Instead, patients will be asked to drink a liter of water during the hour prior to their study. If it is determined that oral contrast is needed, the patient will be given a small amount to drink here. No more drinking of contrast 2 and 4 hours prior to exams.

Some of the other benefits of our new Multi-Slice CT include:

- Acquisitions of large volumes of data very quickly
- High quality, Fast scanning
- Reduced IV contrast dosing
- The newest software and technology
- Increased patient weight limit to 450 lbs.
- Little or NO oral contrast.

After initial training, referring physicians and staff will be provided with information regarding the additional services that we will have available for your patients. In the mean time feel free to contact us with any questions you may have.

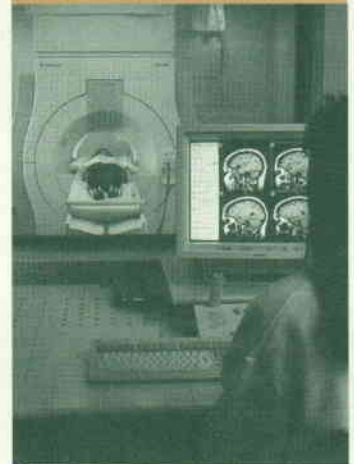
